There will be over 30 Olympians at Edmonton's event including flag bearer at the Rio games, double gold medalist in trampoline, Rosie MacLennan, Rio chef de mission and multi medalist, Curt Harnett, Rio Olympic gold medalist in wresting, Erica Wiebe and Rio CBC Olympic analyst, Mark Tewksbury.

"But the other stars of the show are the ten participating chefs", notes Bill Butler, Edmonton Co-Chair, "they have been working for months preparing their culinary creations and finding the perfect beverage to match, all in the hopes of winning gold to go onto compete at the Canadian Culinary Championships in Kelowna in February and win the title of best chef in Canada and win a 2 year lease on a BMW."
